DIVISION INFORMATION

1st - 6th place ribbons awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve for each division.

- (1-3) <u>Walk-Trot</u>: Open to riders in their *first year* of showing regardless of age. May also show in Pleasure Walk-Trot and Open Eq. Walk-Trot. Will be split (A)13&under, (B)14&up if entries warrant.
- (4-6) <u>Pleasure Horse/Pony</u>: Open to all eligible riders on horse/pony.
- (7-9) Walk-Trot-Canter: Will be split (A)13&under, (B)14&up if entries warrant.
- (10-12) <u>Crossrail EQ</u>: Open to riders in their *first or second year of showing O/F* regardless of age. Twice around the outside lines. Simple changes allowed. May also show in Walk-Trot-Canter, Pleasure and Open EQ. Flat classes.
- (13-15) <u>Future Hunter</u>: Open horse or riders who have NOT yet shown higher than 2'. Simple changes allowed. Twice around the outside lines. May also show in Open Equitation, and Schooling Hunter.
- (16-18) Open Equitation: Flat classes open to all eligible riders. Open EQ. O/F to be shown prior to each hunter division at your respective fence height (2', 2'3, 2'6, 2'9).
- (19-31) <u>Schooling, Low, Open, Working Hunter</u>: Open to all eligible riders on horse/pony. Schooling and Low Hunter may be combined if less than 3 entries in each. Open and Working Hunter may be combined if less than 3 entries in each.

2' HLF MINI-MEDAL

Open to HLF series members who have not shown over fences exceeding 2'3". To be judged on position and control of mount. A test may be included in the initial round or at the judge's discretion. Three competitors must complete the course for points to be awarded. Top 6 riders will receive awards. All those with points in the Mini-Medal will be eligible for Medal Finals.

HLF HUNTER DERBY @ 2'3, 2'6, 2'9

Open to eligible HLF series members. First round score will come from your *second hunter trip in your respective division (2'3, 2'6, 2'9). Top 10 riders to return for a second round, a handy type course, which may include natural obstacles, rollbacks, bending lines, and/or trot jump. Three competitors must complete the course for points to be awarded. Top 6 riders will receive awards. All those with points in the Derby will be eligible for Derby Finals.

Minimum of 6 riders to fill. ** ENTRIES FOR THE DERBY MUST BE MADE NO LATER THAN THE SECOND SCHOOLING BREAK**

- ** Walk-Trot and Walk-Trot-Canter divisions may be split if entries warrant
 - ** Schooling Hunter and Low Hunter may be combined if entries warrant
 - ** Open Hunter and Working Hunter may be combined if entries warrant

- ASTM approved helmets must be worn when mounted no exceptions!
- Negative Coggins required.
